

GLOBAL SOUTH SCHOLAR-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAMME CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

The Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies invites applications for its newly created fellowship programme devised for **university teachers** holding a **PhD** – with a preference for **women and junior academics** – from **Africa, Asia and Latin America**.

Candidates must be specialised in the fields of:

- International Affairs
- Development Studies

or in the disciplines of:

- Anthropology and Sociology
- International Economics
- International Law
- International Relations / Political Science
- International History and Politics

For each semester, three candidates will be invited to spend between **three and five months** at the Institute located in the heart of international Geneva in order:

- to update and strengthen their teaching curriculum
- to further a personal research project
- to interact with the Institute's faculty and postgraduate students

Expenses covered by the programme include

- travel, visa, insurance, accommodation costs
- participants receive a monthly stipend to compensate for the loss of income in the institution of origin and cover living costs in Geneva

Application deadline

- 1 March for the Autumn semester
- 1 October for the Spring semester
